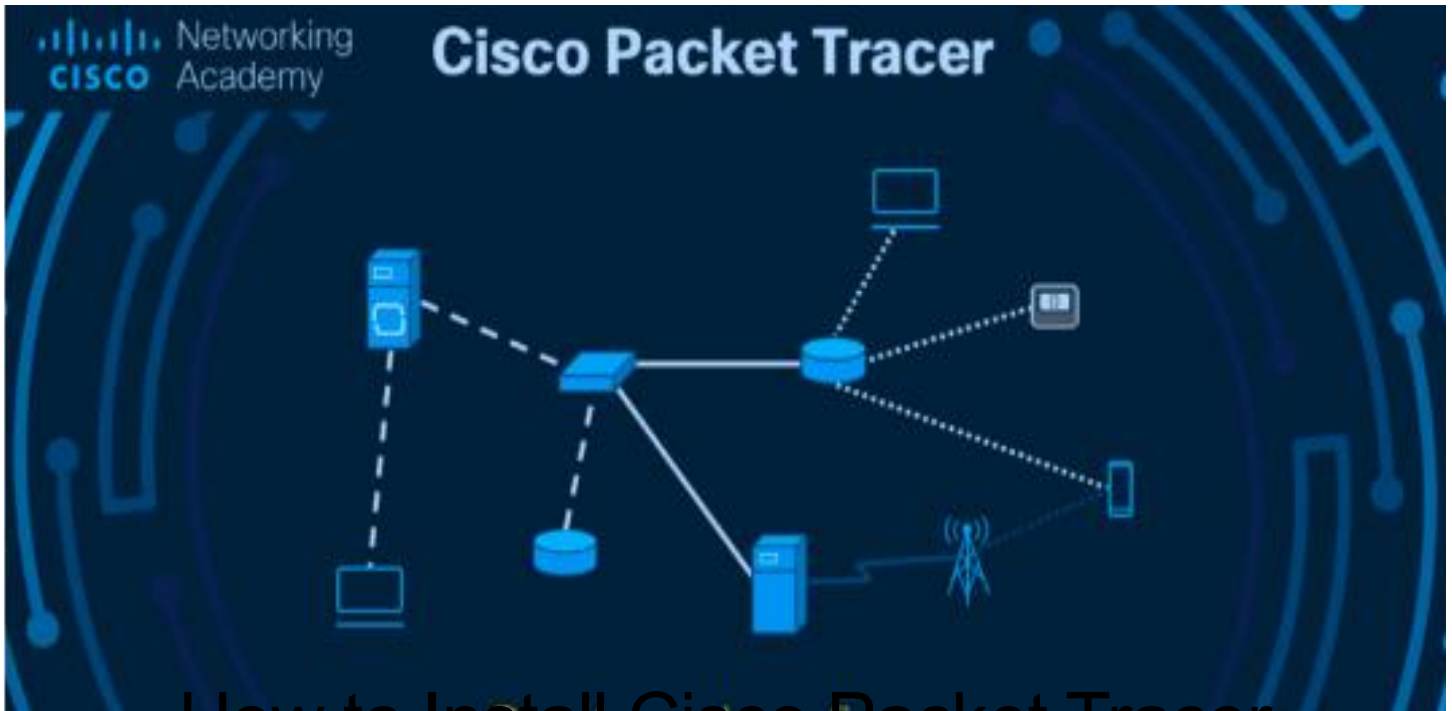




How to Install Cisco Packet Tracer

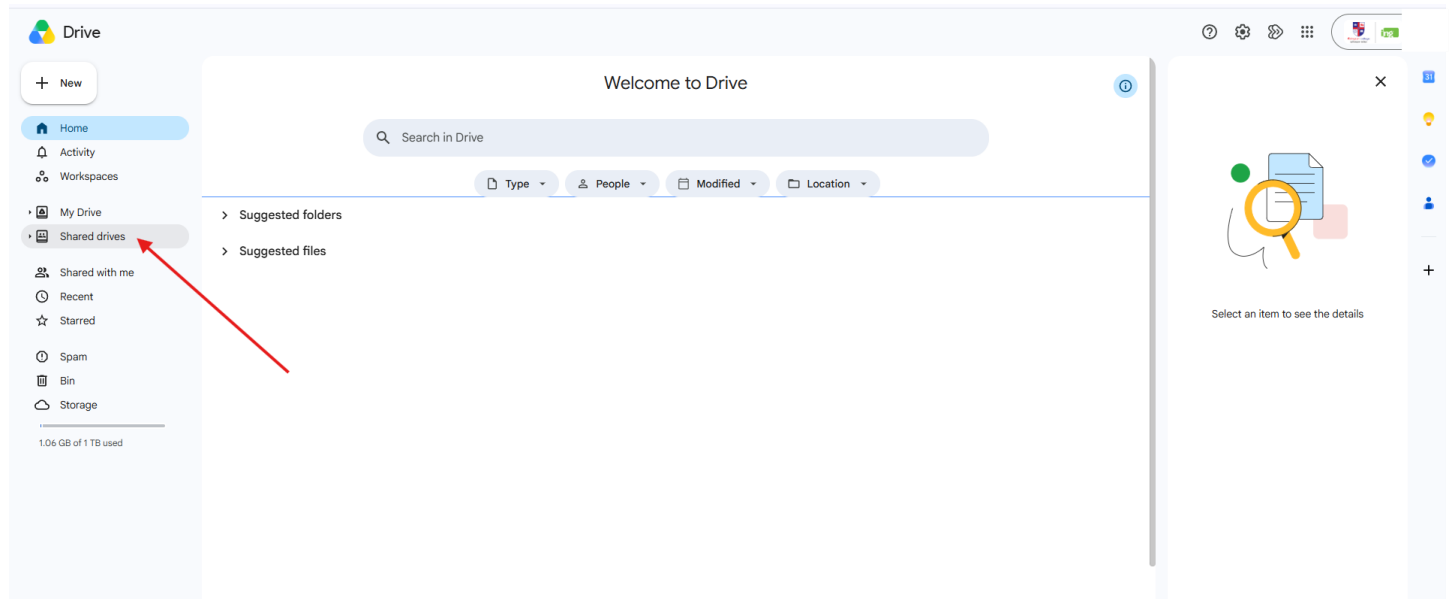

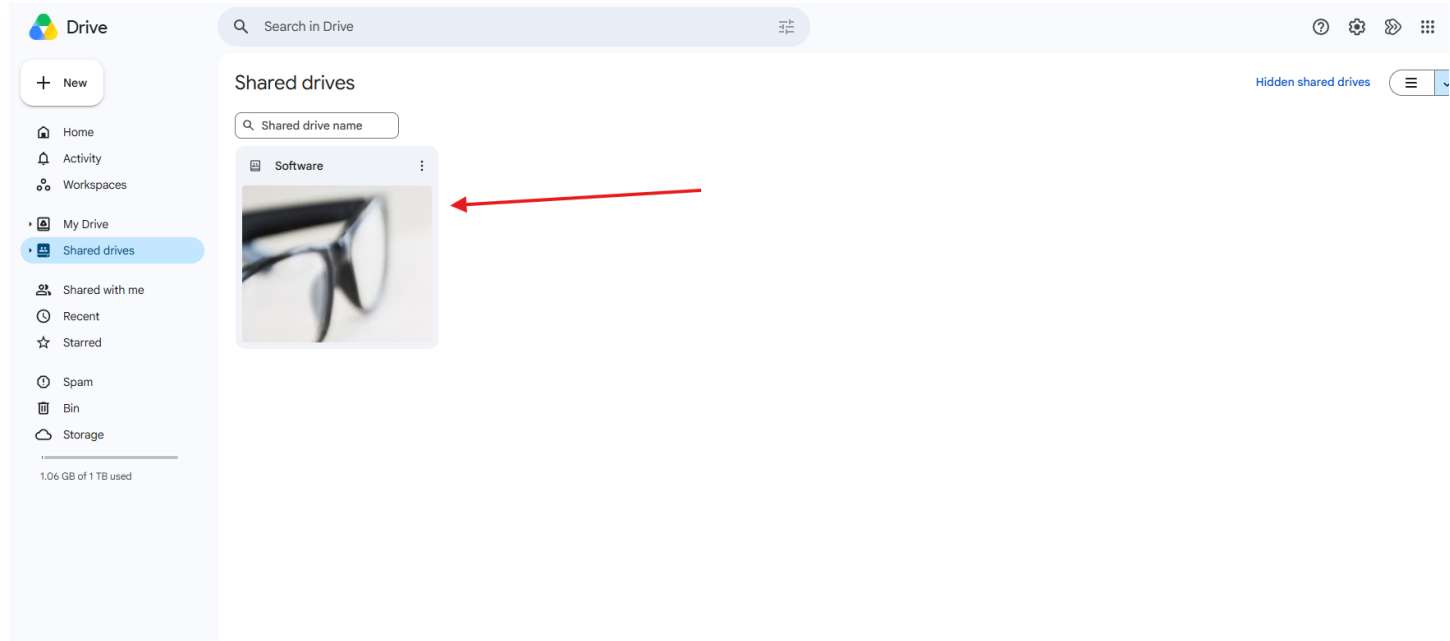

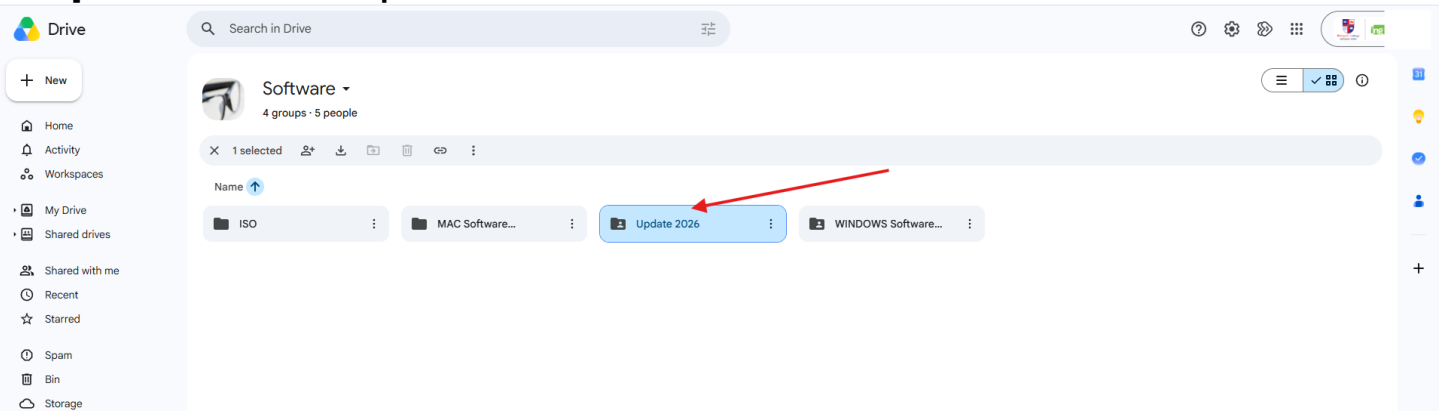
Step 2 : You will be directed to google drive upon signing in or if your already logged into the email account. Navigate to shared drives as shown below.



Step 3 : In the shared drives, you will find the Software folder. Click on the folder.

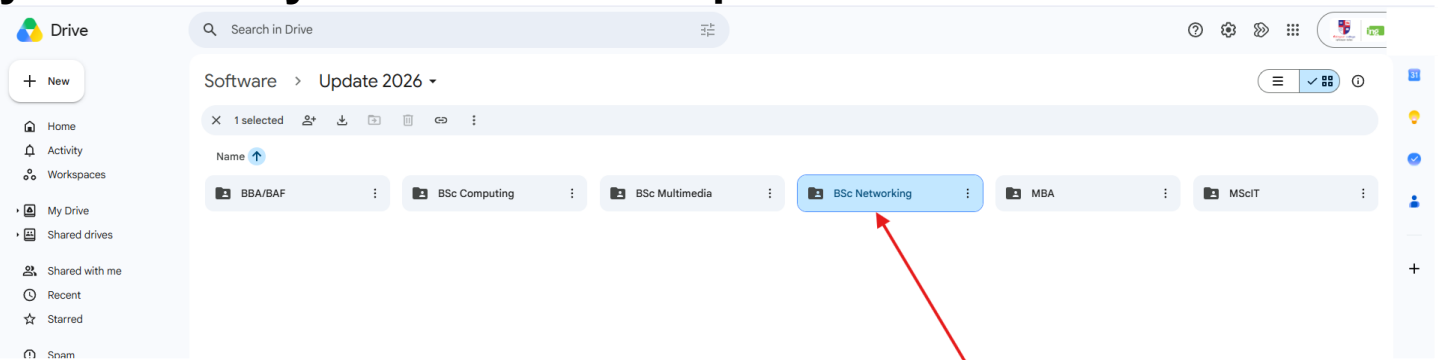


Step 4 : Click on Updated 2026.

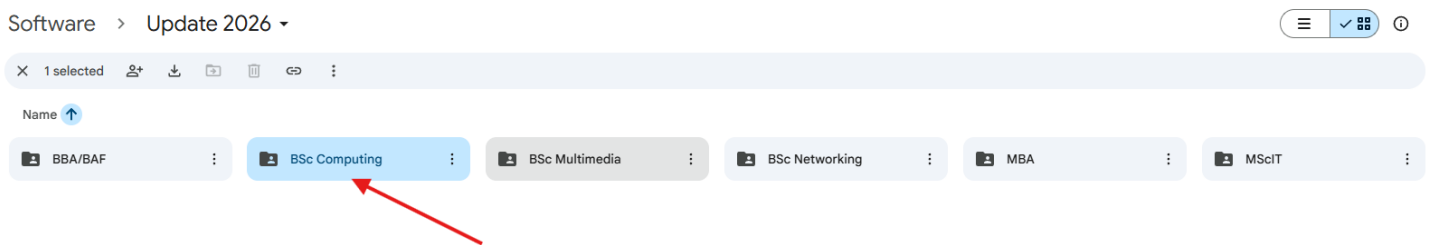


Step 5 : After getting into Update 2026, you will find folders with your faculty name. Selected the one in which you are a part of.

Note: Your faculty folder determines the available of the software you need for your normal class operations.

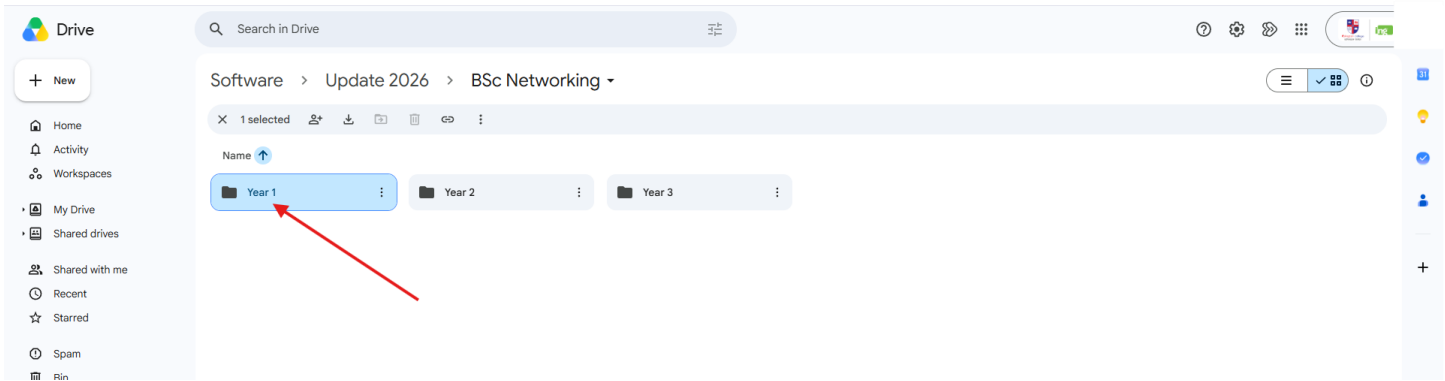

Step 6 : After selecting the faculty, select the year in which you are enrolled in. For this case, I have chosen Year 1.

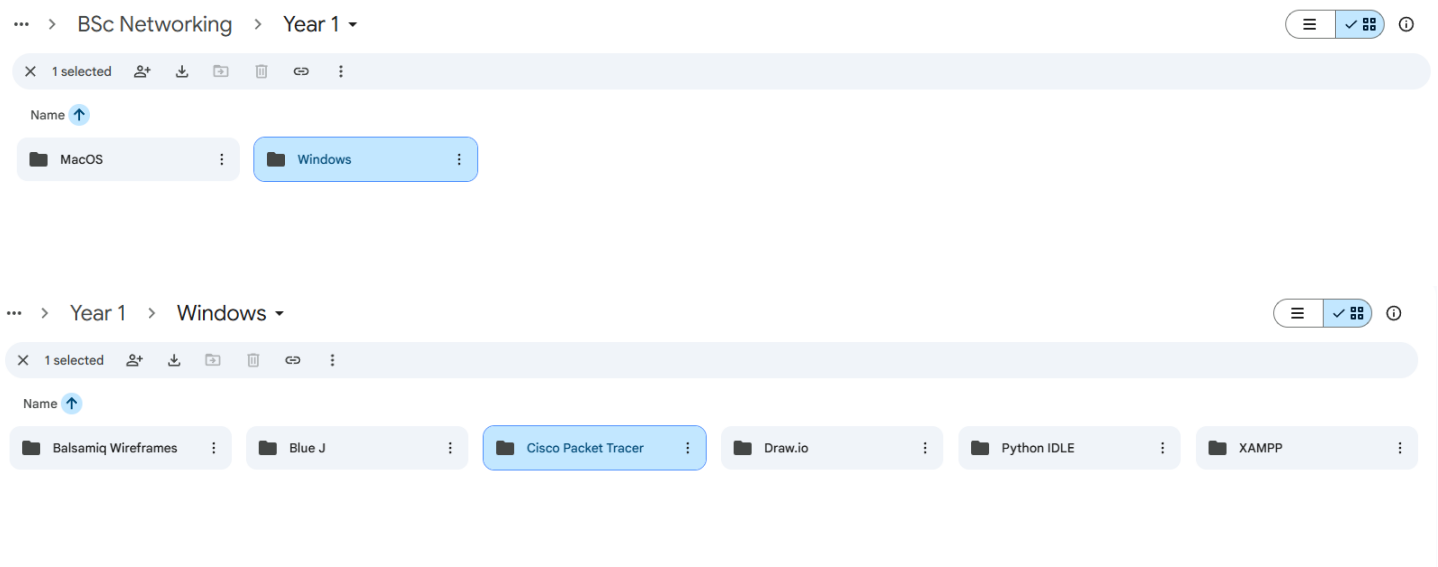
NOTE: for BSc. Computing, only Year 1 has cisco packet tracker.



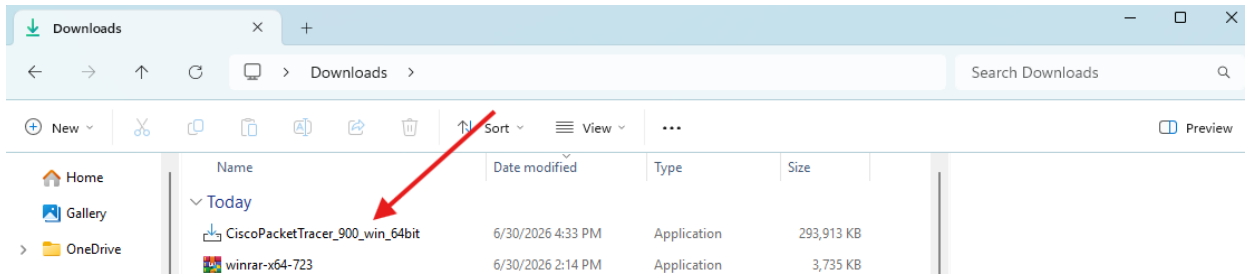

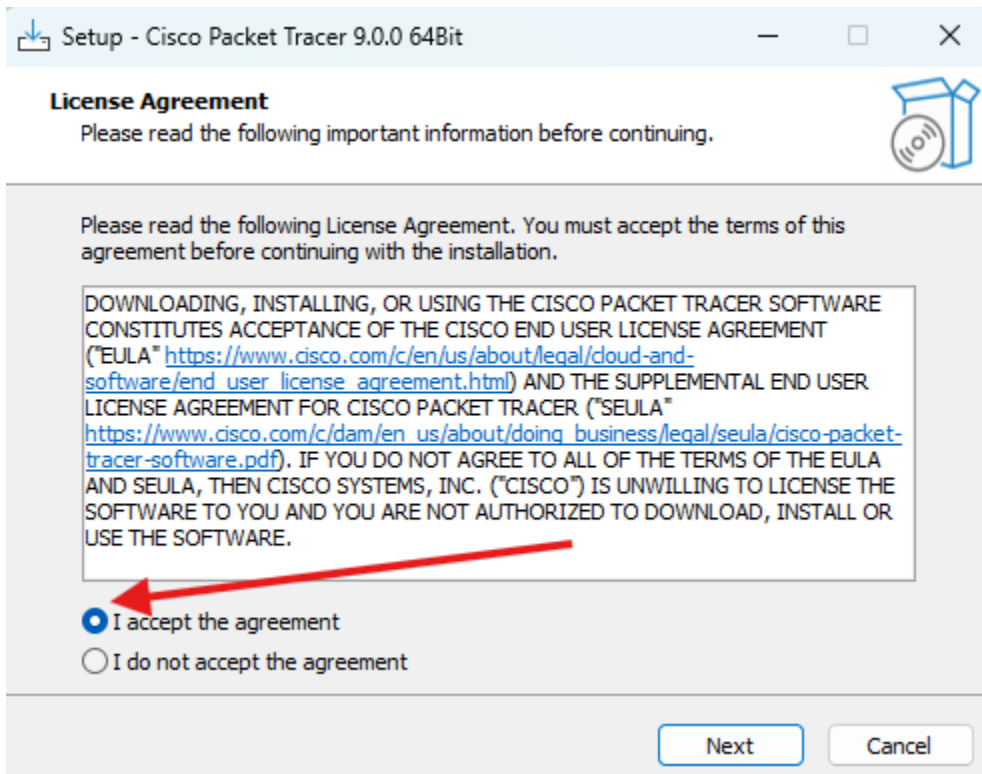
After clicking the selected year, you will be provided with options of the OS that might be currently installed in your laptop. Selected the correct OS and click on cisco packet tracker. You will find the current version that is supportive for your classes there. Download it.



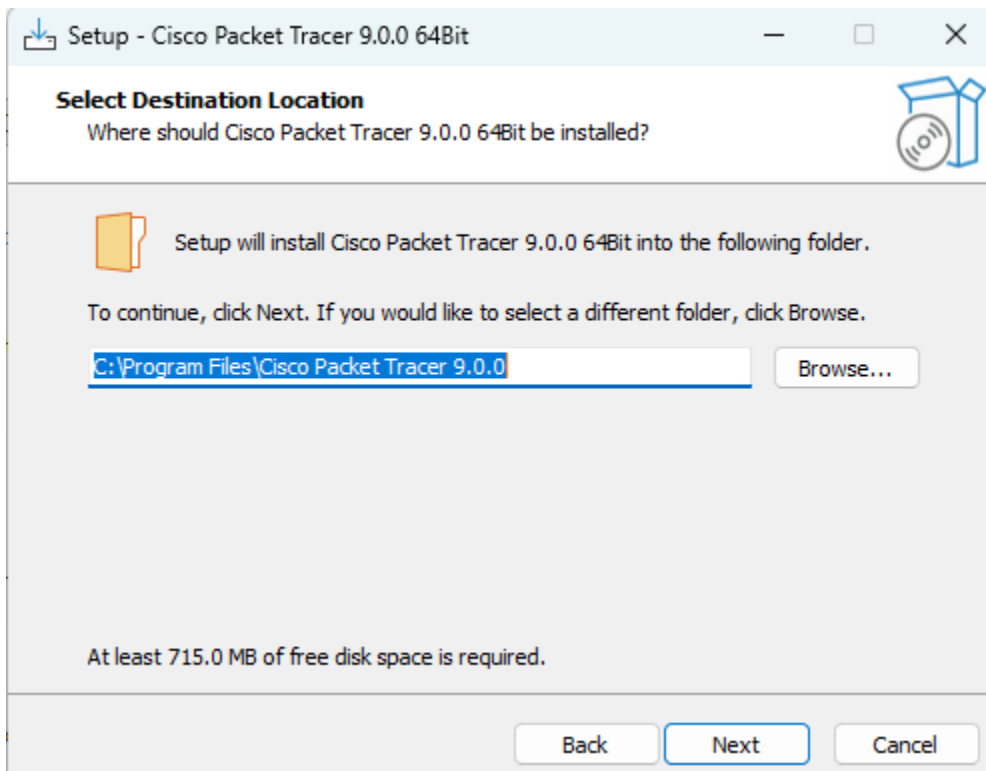
Step 7: Wait for the download to be completed and navigate to the download folder or the place where your downloaded files are saved. Click on the downloaded file and run it.



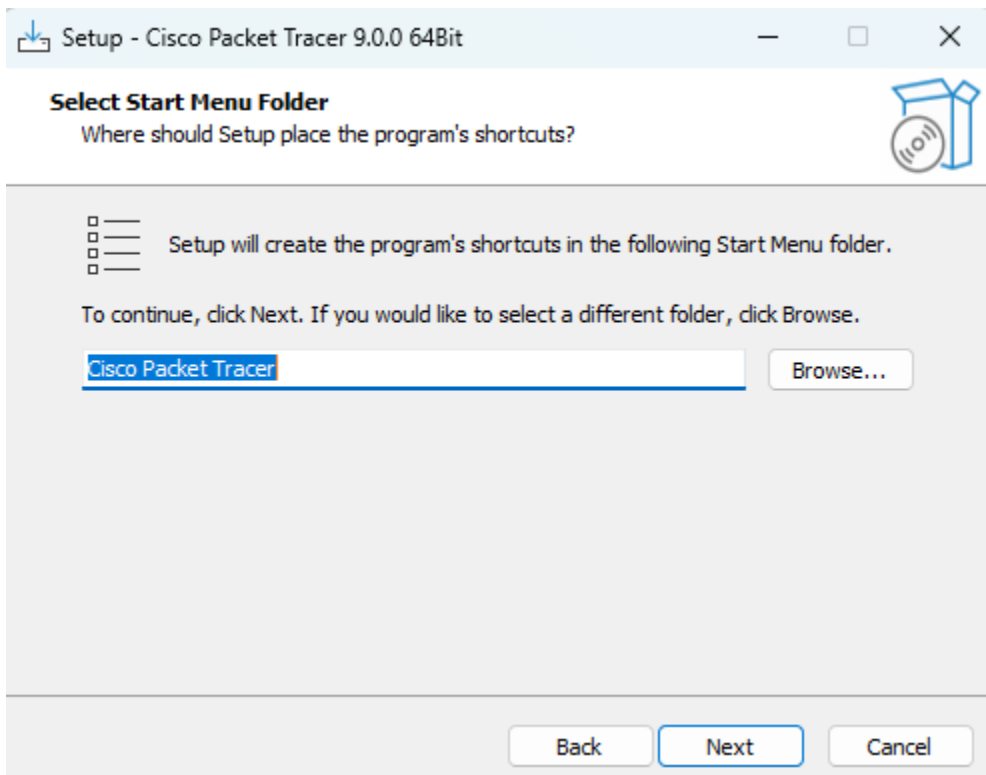
Step 8 : After running the setup file select the I accept the agreement to proceed forward.



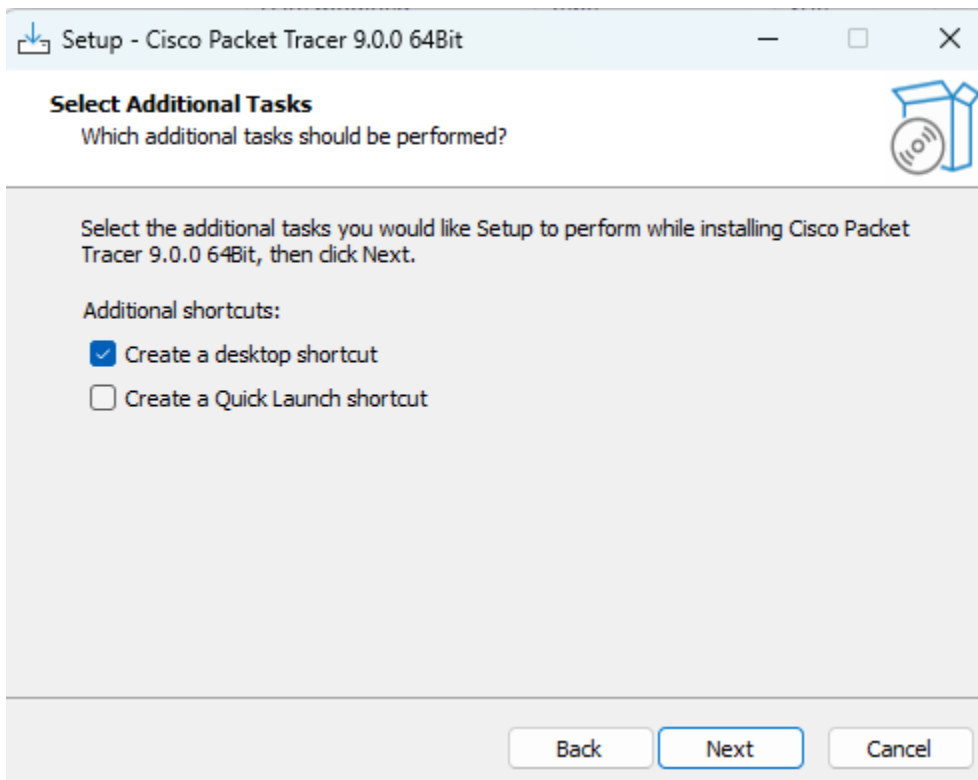
Step 9 : Select the location where you want to install the file or if unsure leave it as default and click on Next.



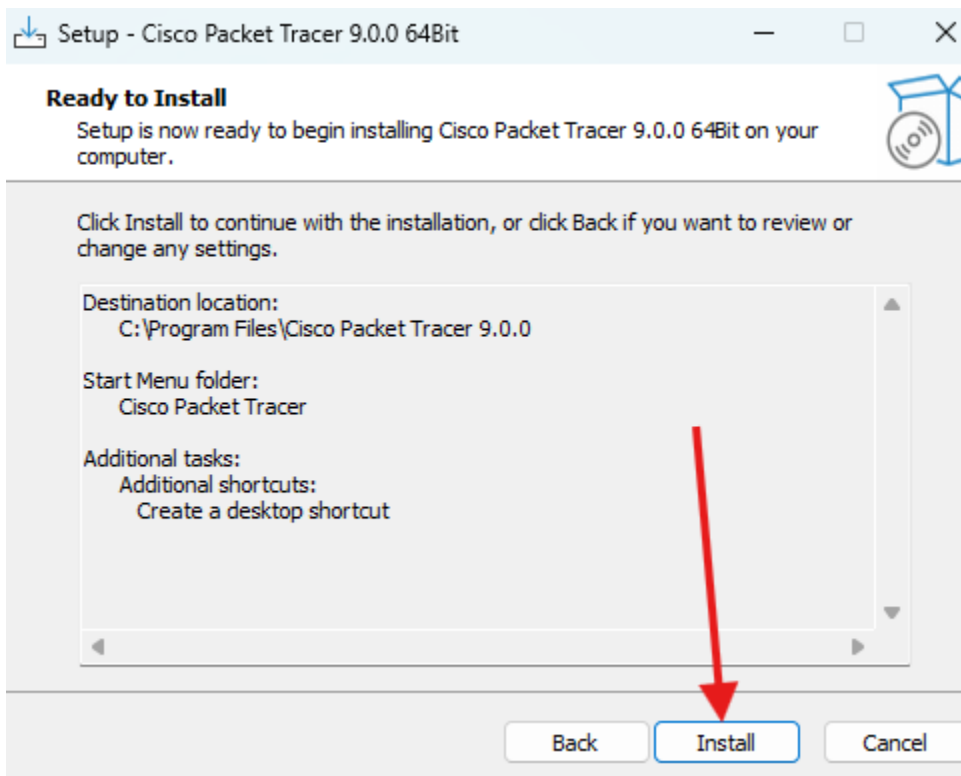
Step 10 : Click on Next.



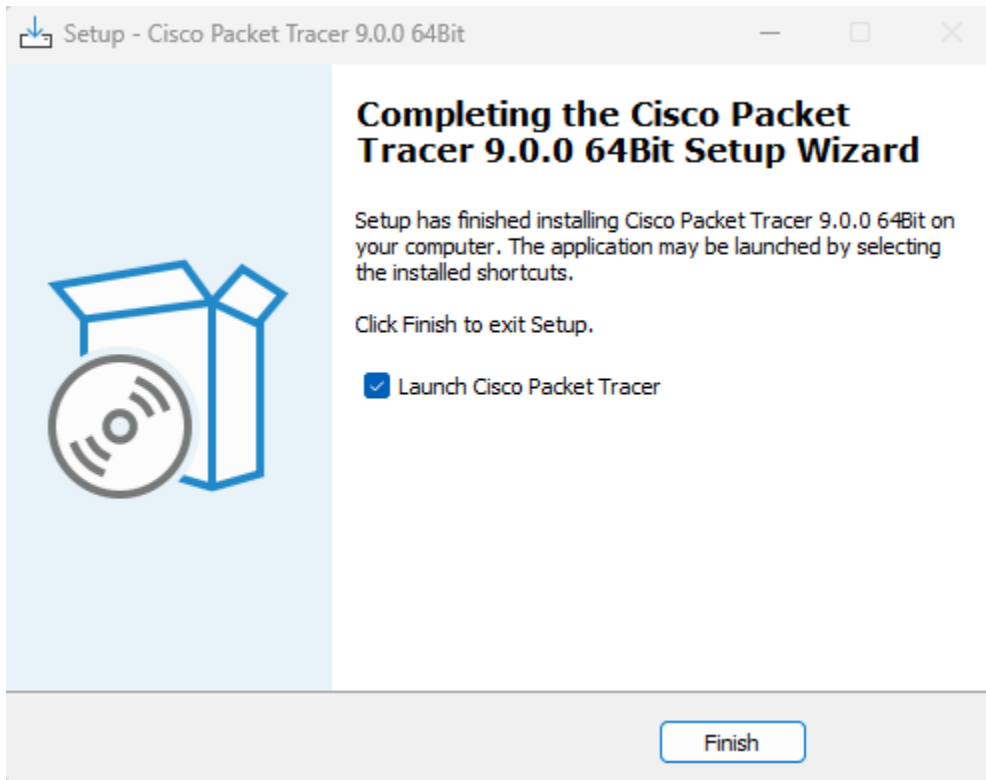
Step11 : Select the options for shortcut if you would like easier access to the files and click Next.



Step 12 : Verify your selections and click install.

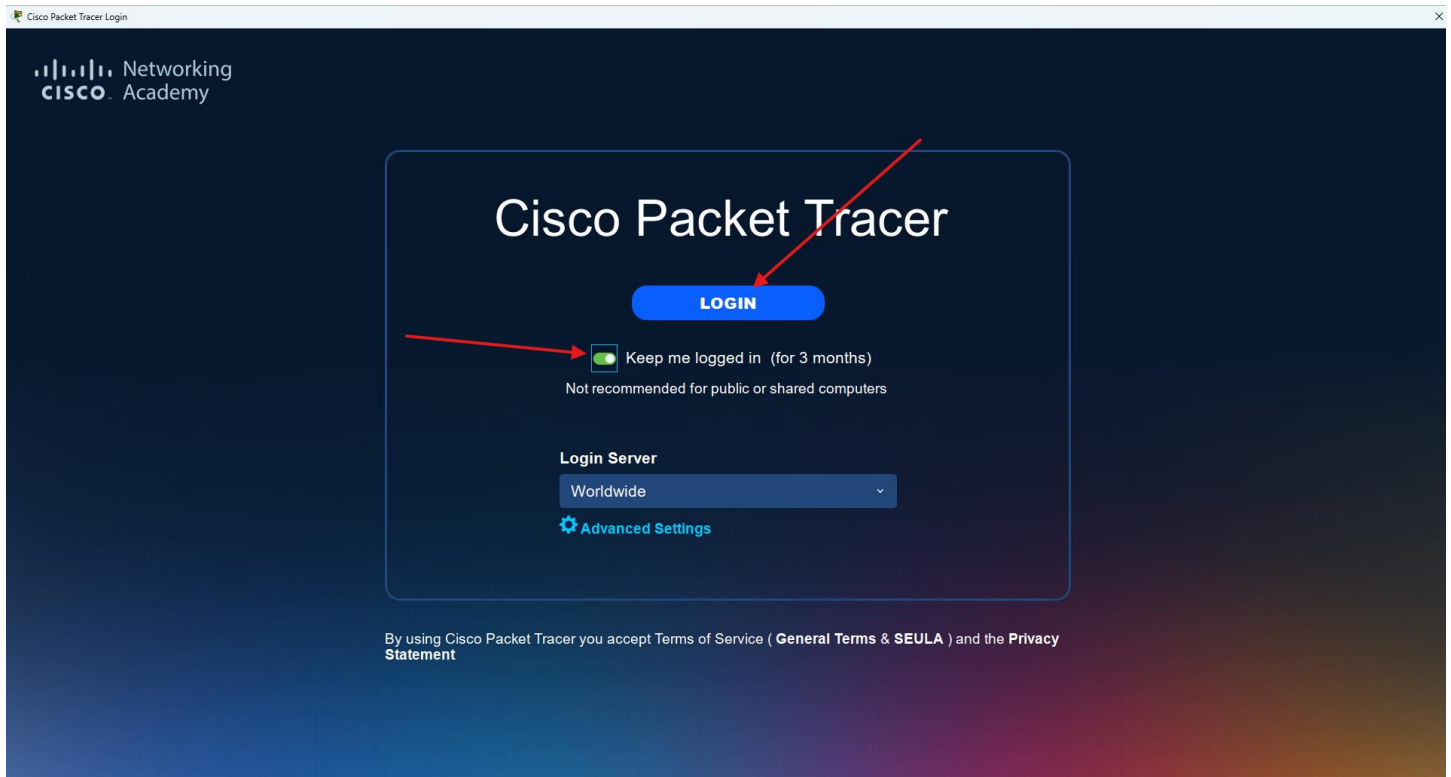


Step 13 : wait for the installation to complete and after completion click finish.

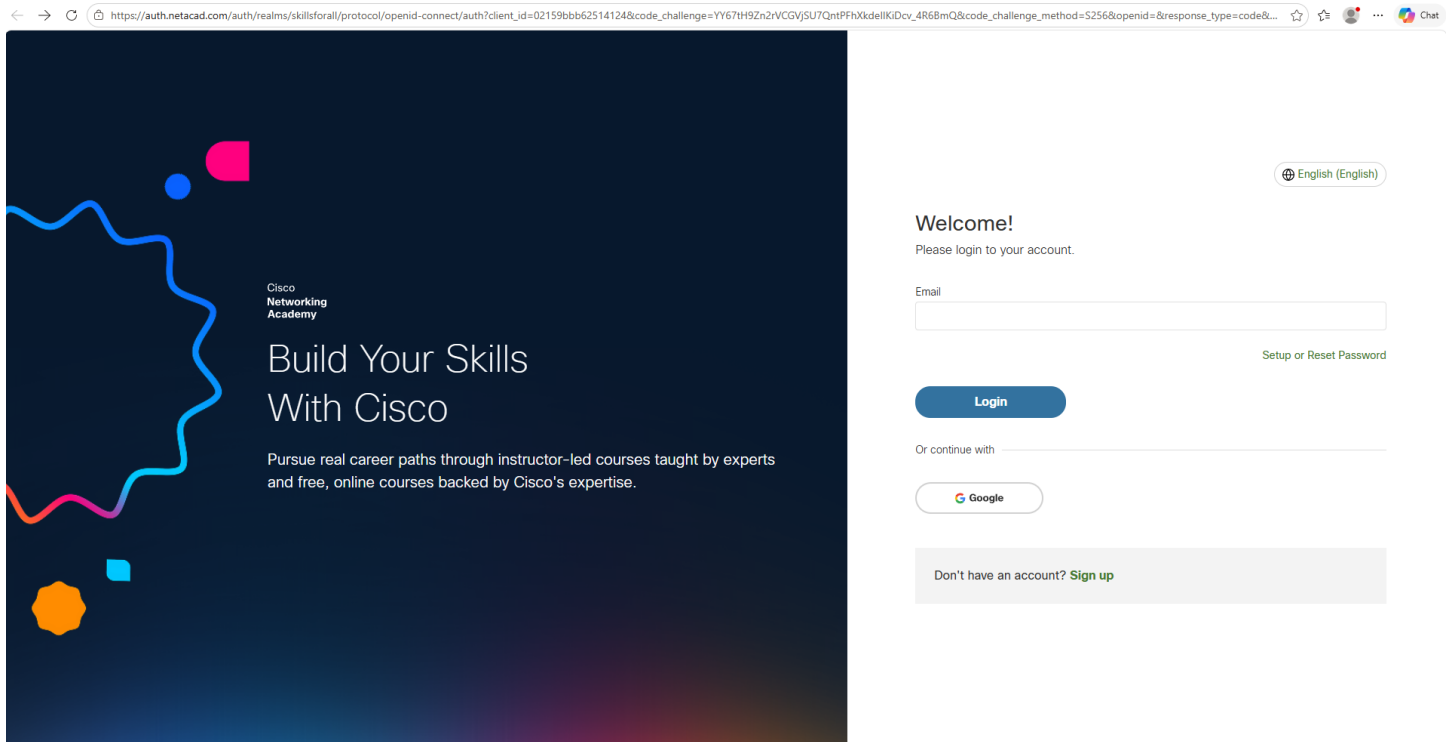


Step 14 : Cisco Packet Tracer is Successfully installed in your device. Login with your College email address to access the application.

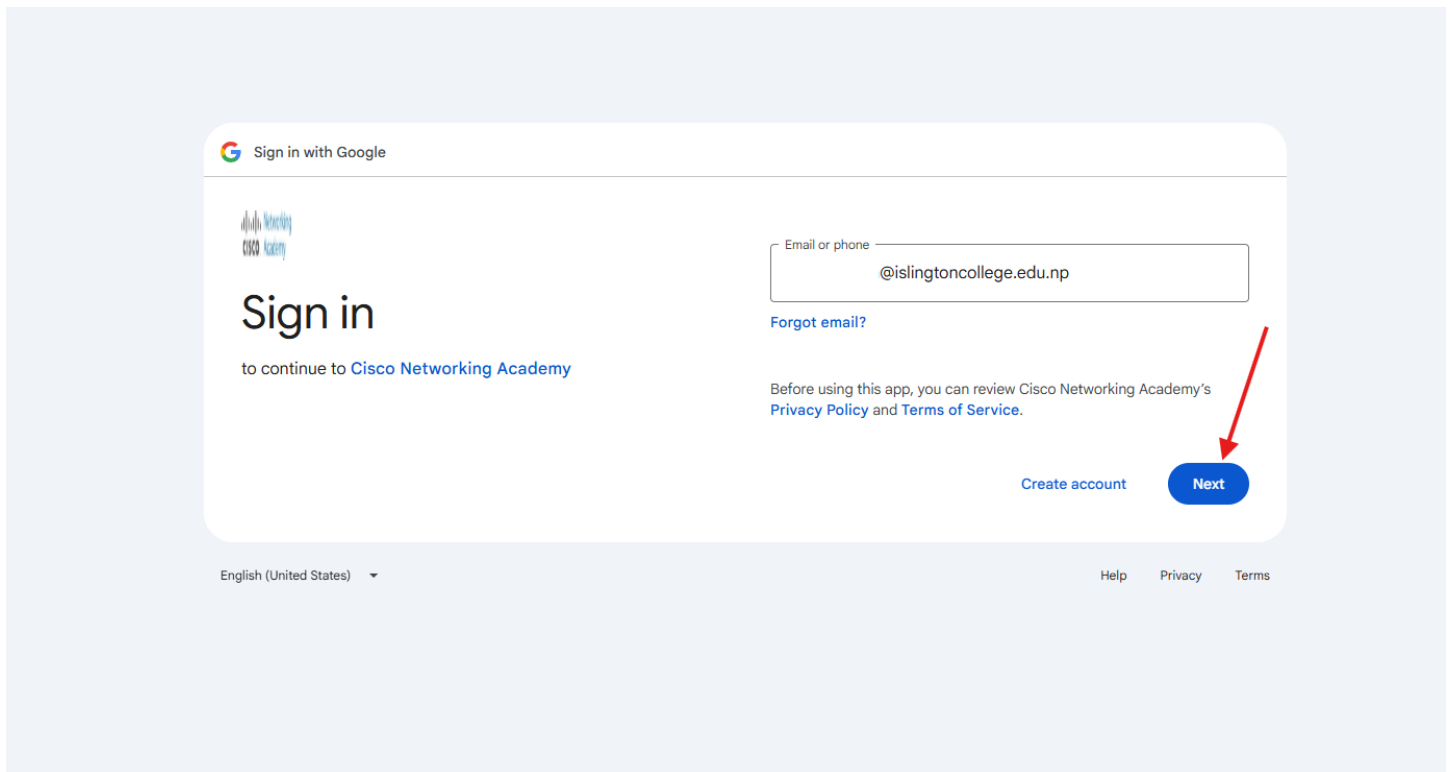
Note: Please select to keep me logged in (for 3 months) so that you would not need to log in every time you access the application.

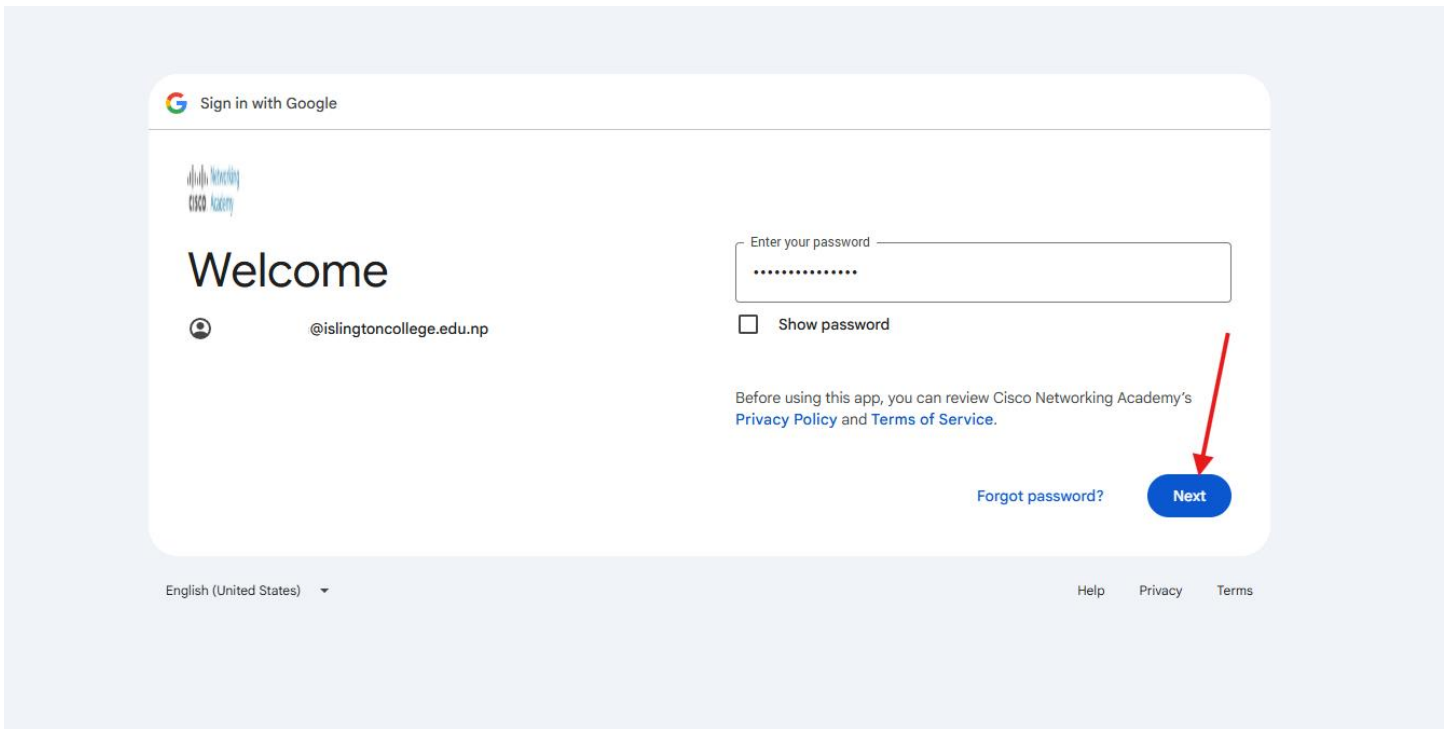


Step 15: On clicking login, you will be redirected to a page in your default browser. Please log in through the browser to login to the application.



Step 16: Enter your college email address and password and log in.





Step 17: After signing in with your account. The page will reload and you may not close the page and open your cisco packet tracker. It will automatically log in. **Congratulations, you have now successfully installed Cisco packet tracker.**
