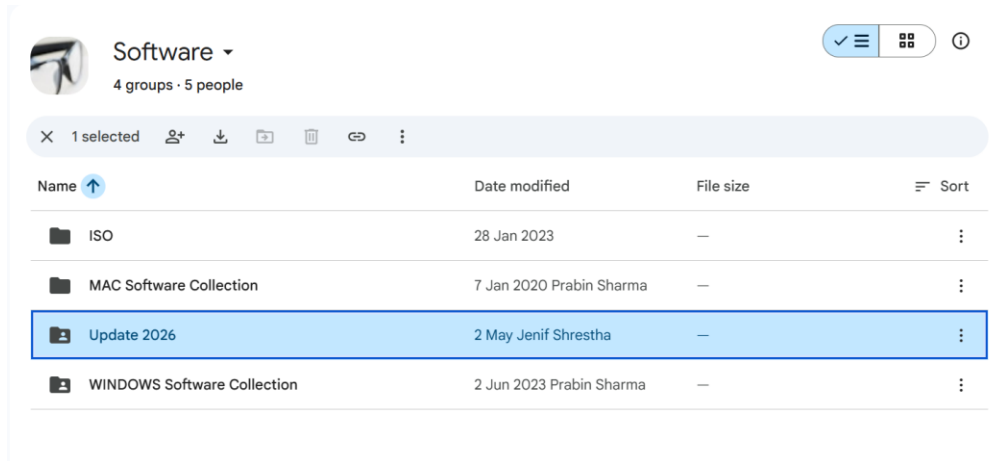


Power BI Desktop Installation Guide

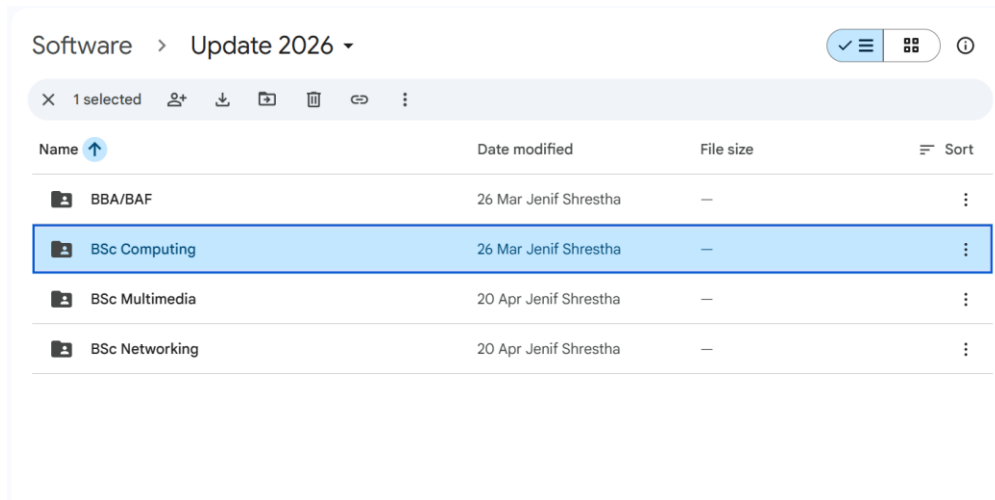
Step 1. Open the Software Drive

Open the shared Software drive and click on the “Update 2026” folder.



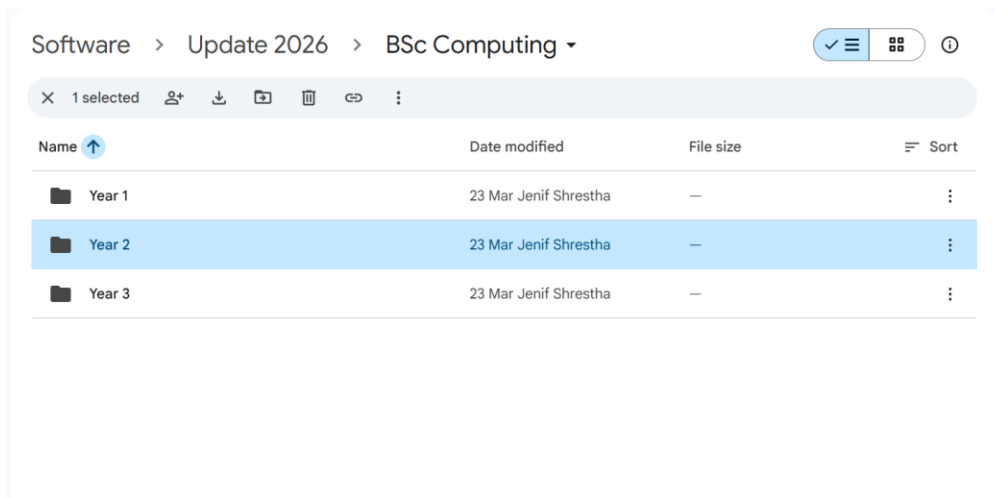
Step 2. Open BSc Computing

Inside “Update 2026”, open the “BSc Computing” folder.



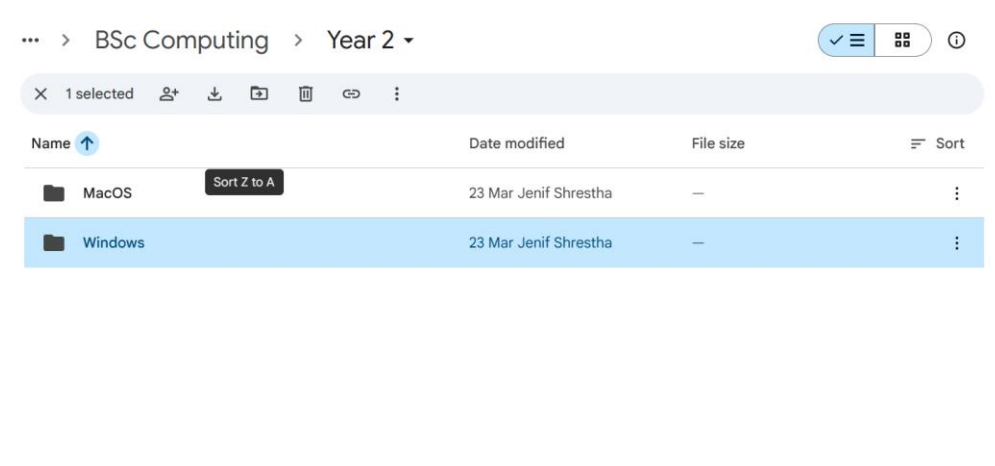
Step 3. Open Year 2

Open the “Year 2” folder.



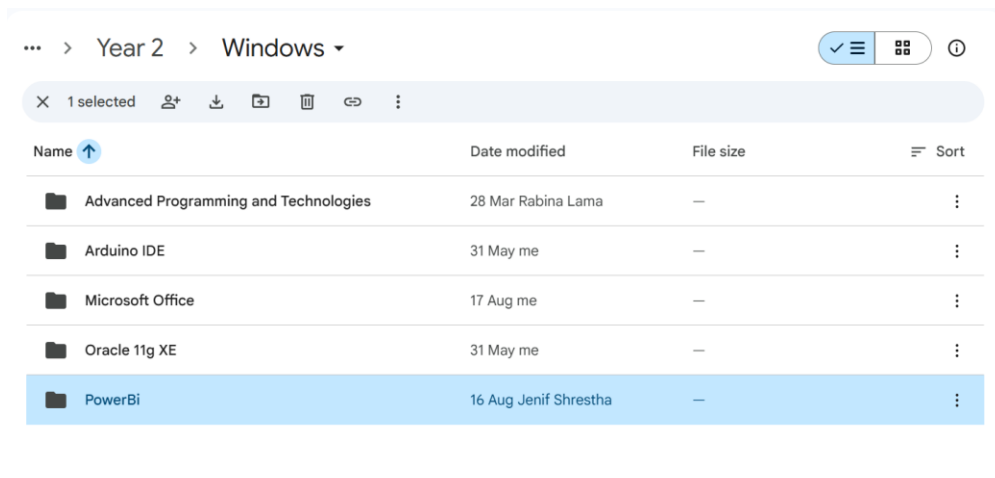
Step 4. Open Windows

Open the “Windows” folder.



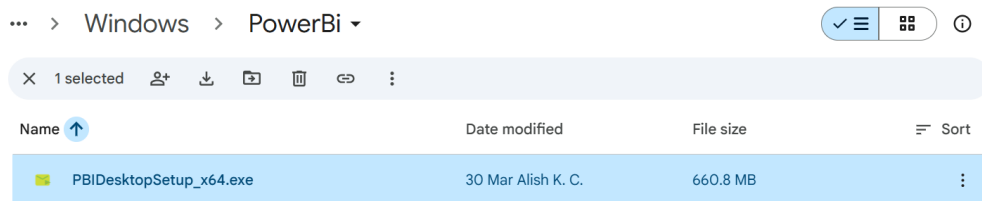
Step 5. Open PowerBi

Open the “PowerBi” folder.



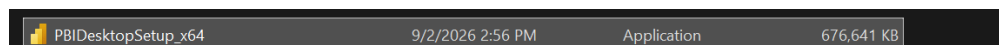
Step 6. Download the Installer

Select the file “PBIDesktopSetup_x64.exe” and download it to your computer.



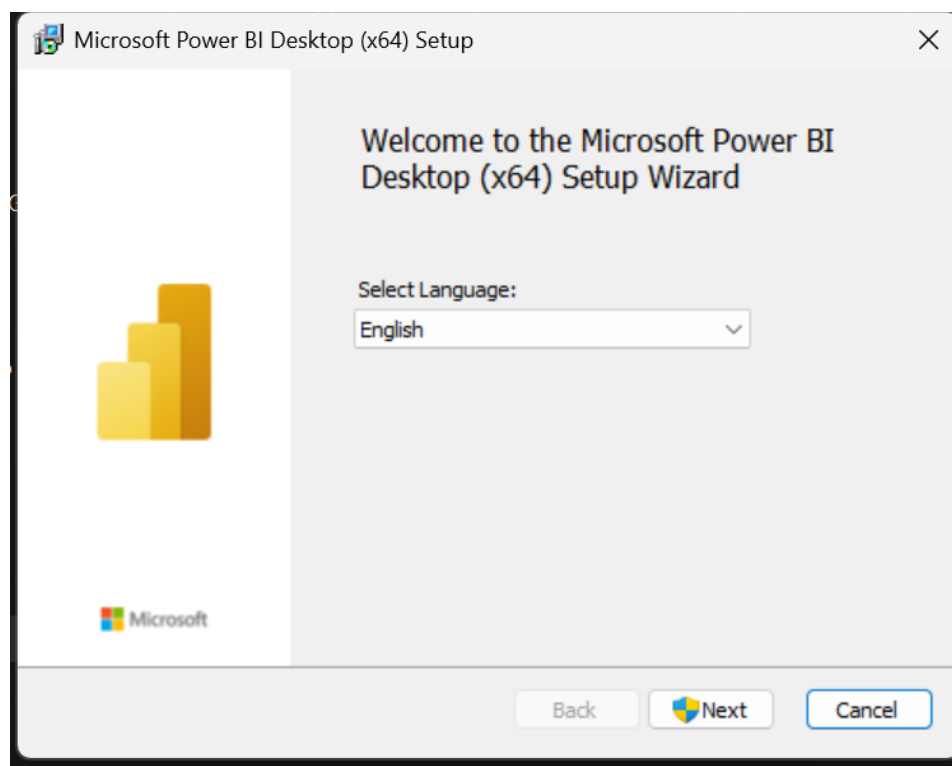
Step 7. Run the Installer

Go to your Downloads folder and double-click “PBIDesktopSetup_x64” to start the installation.



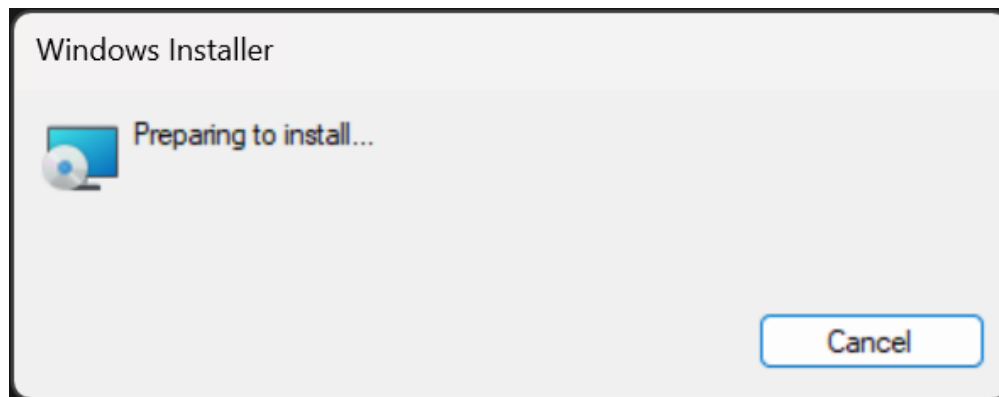
Step 8. Select a Language

Choose your preferred language and click “Next”.



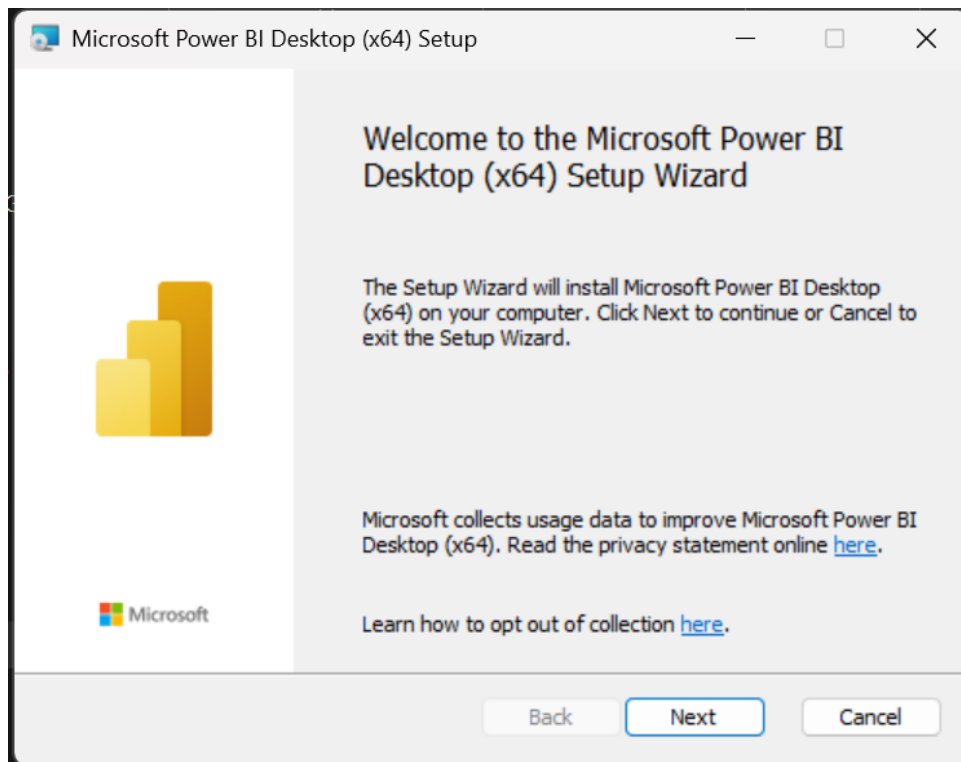
Step 9. Wait for Preparation

Wait while Windows Installer prepares the setup files.



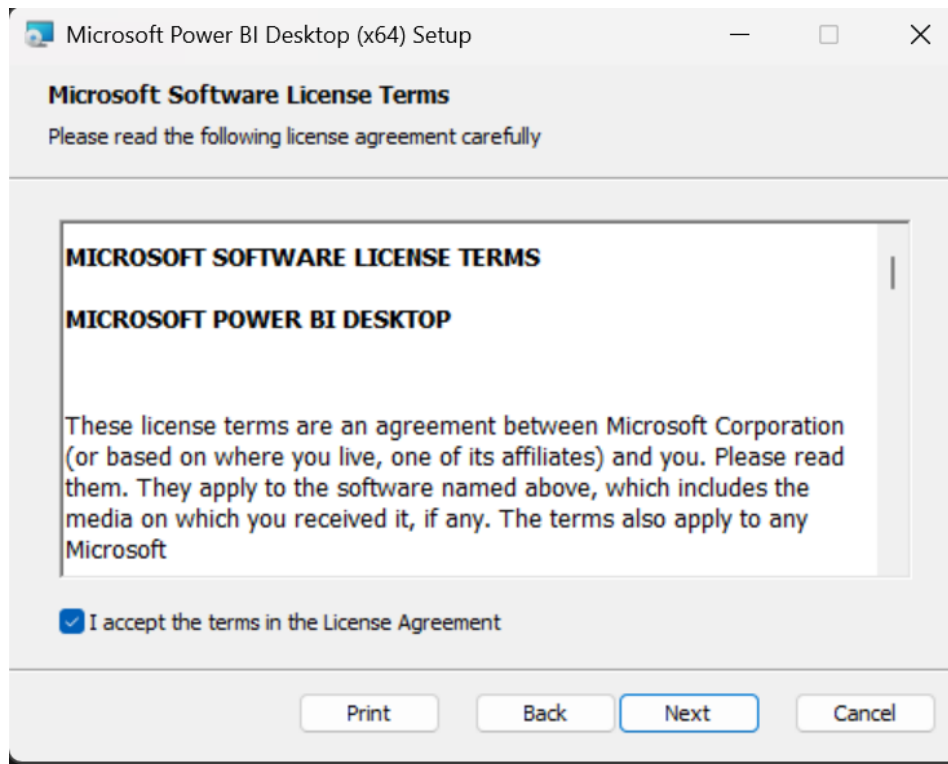
Step 10. Start the Setup Wizard

Click “Next” on the welcome screen to continue.



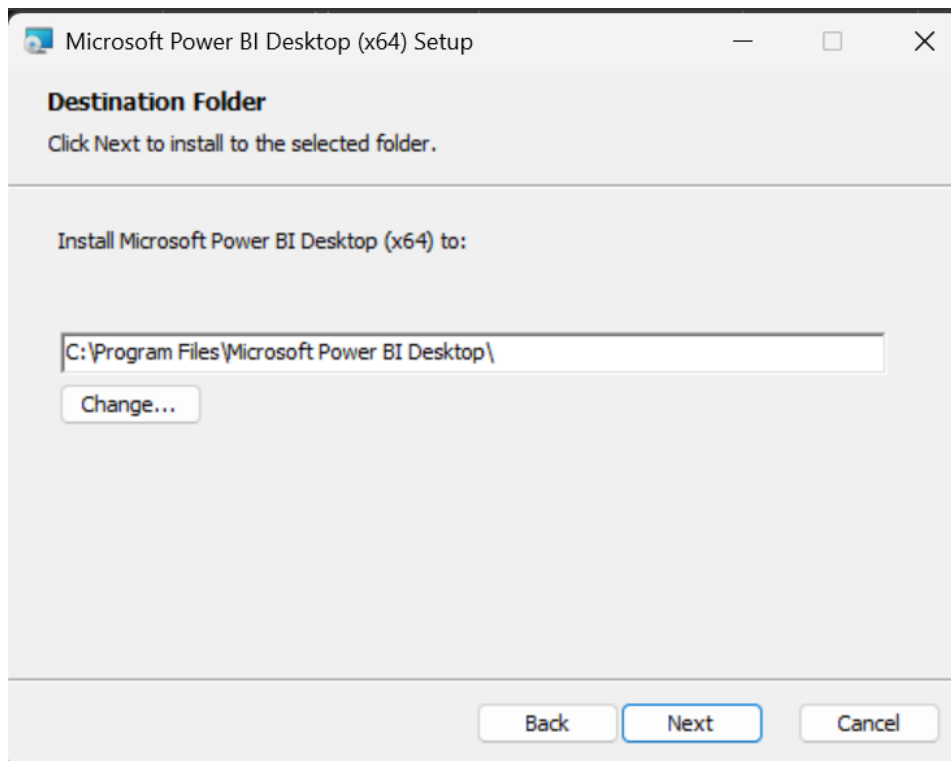
Step 11. Accept the License Terms

Check “I accept the terms in the License Agreement” and click “Next”.



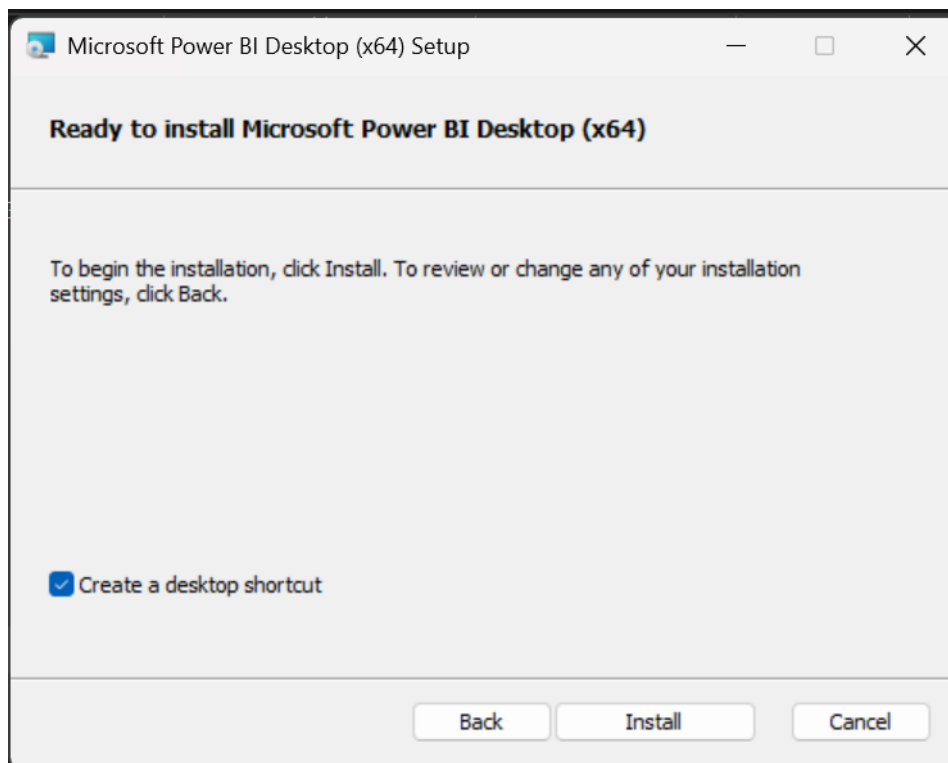
Step 12. Choose the Destination Folder

Leave the default destination folder as it is and click “Next”.



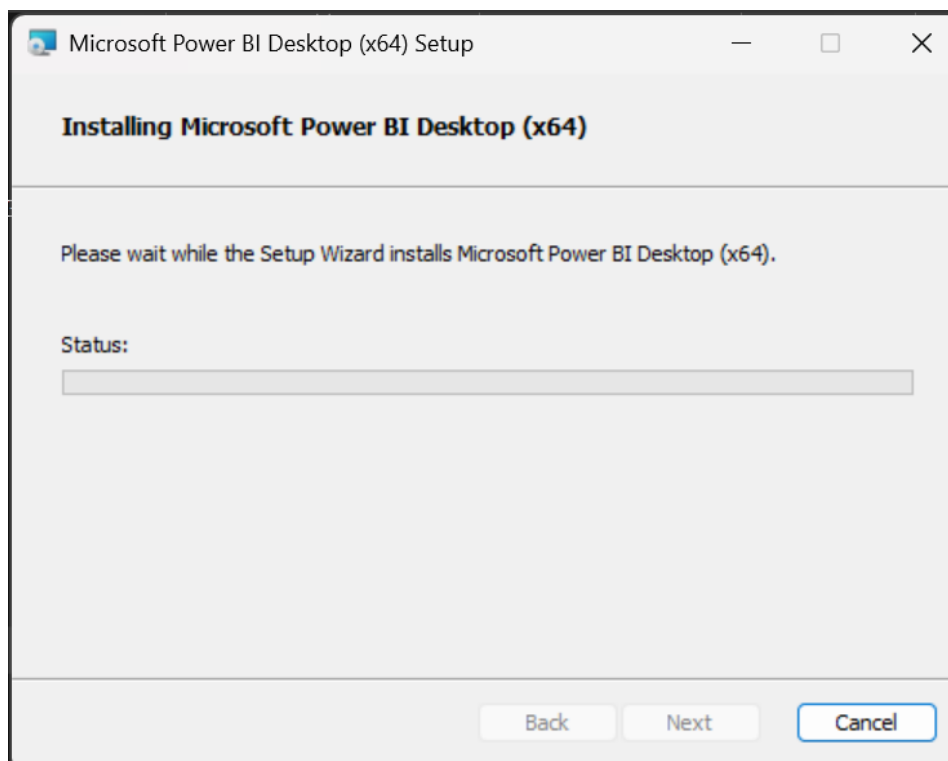
Step 13. Begin Installation

Leave “Create a desktop shortcut” checked and click “Install”.



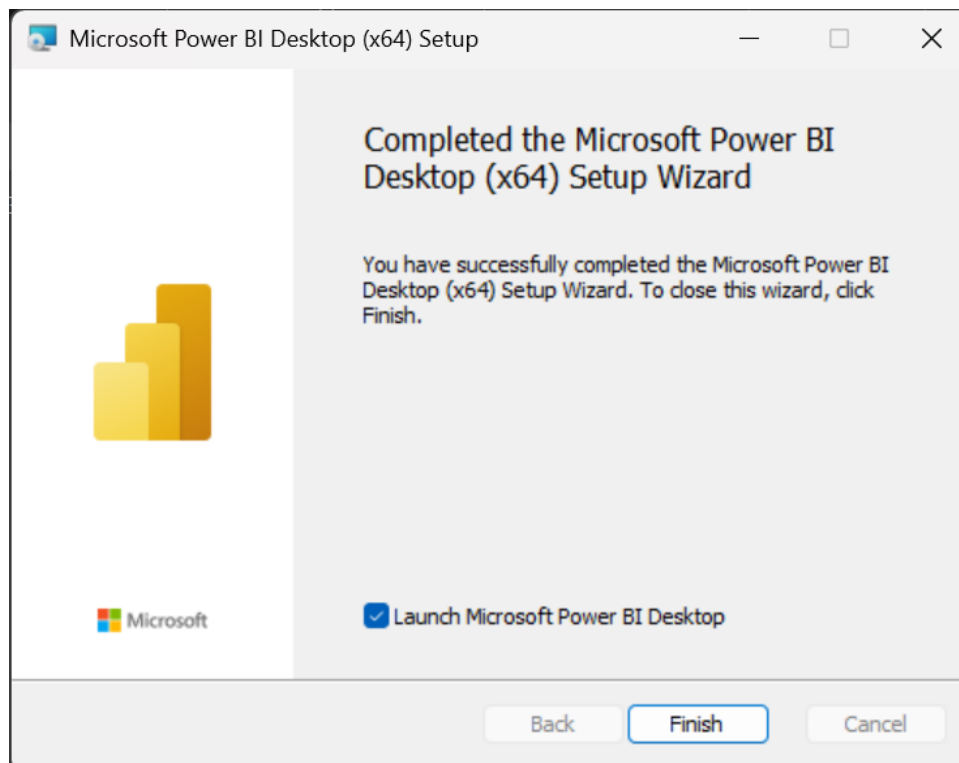
Step 14. Wait for Installation

Wait for the installation to finish. This will only take a moment.



Step 15. Finish Setup

Leave “Launch Microsoft Power BI Desktop” checked and click “Finish”.



Step 16. Installation Complete

Power BI Desktop is now installed and ready to use.
